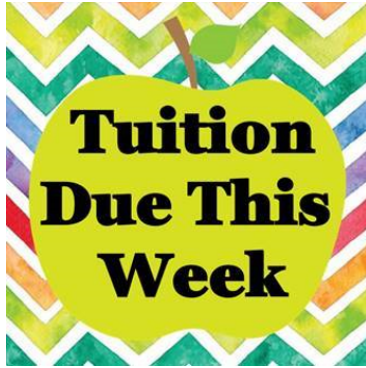

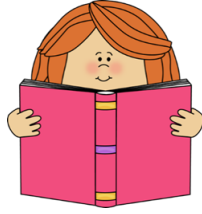

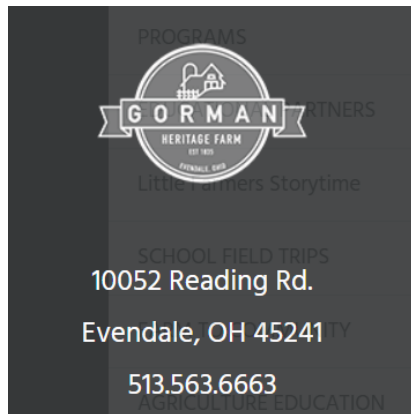
Summer Camp 2025!!

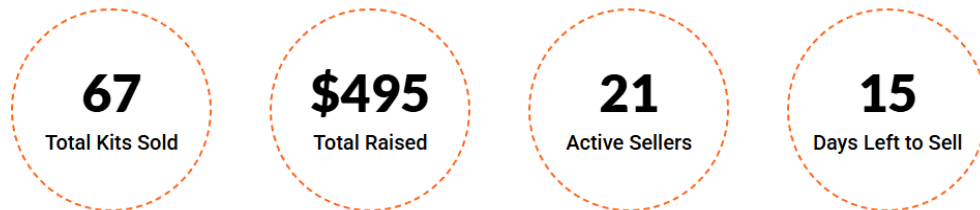
