- Temperature of 100°F in the past 24 hours (without fever reducing medicine)
- Sore throat
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Congestion
- Headache
- Nausea
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Cough (unrelated to chronic condition such as asthma or allergies)

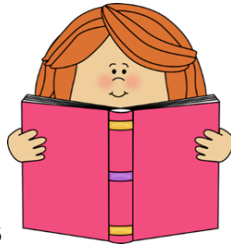


Lunch Bunch Signups
